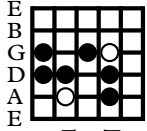


# Ten Minute Tech

## The D Major scale



D Major- 1 Octave (4th position)

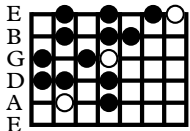
D Major Arpeggio (closed)

Now we will extend the scale to include another octave. Remember, the distance between two D's is always thought of as octave (as in "8"- octagon, octopus etc) because if we play the scale- D E F# G A B C# we have 8 notes! But no matter how many notes we play though, the distance between one D and the next D is always thought of as an octave. And we call the distance between two notes an "interval".
